Season with salt, pepper, garlic, oregano, and basil.



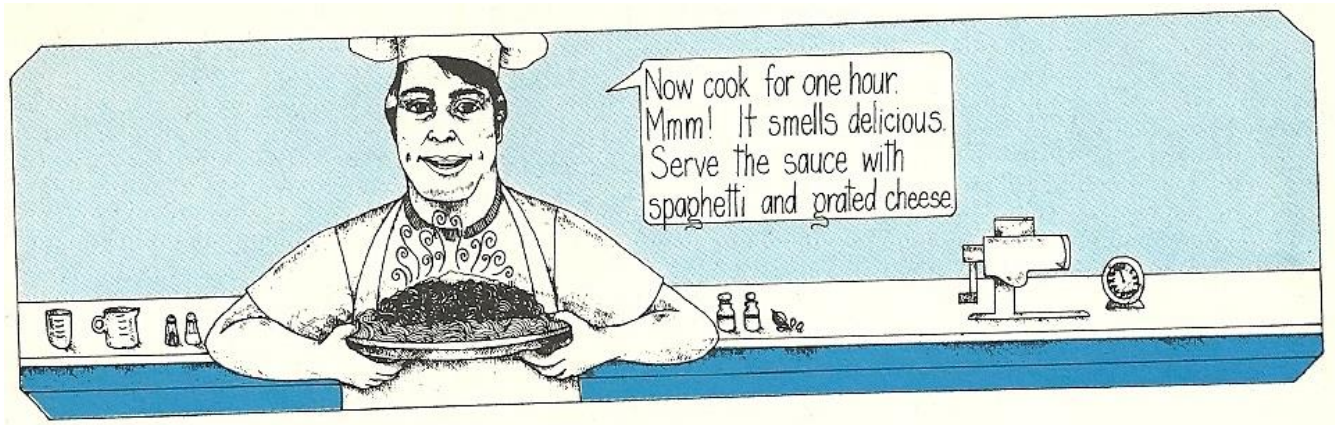

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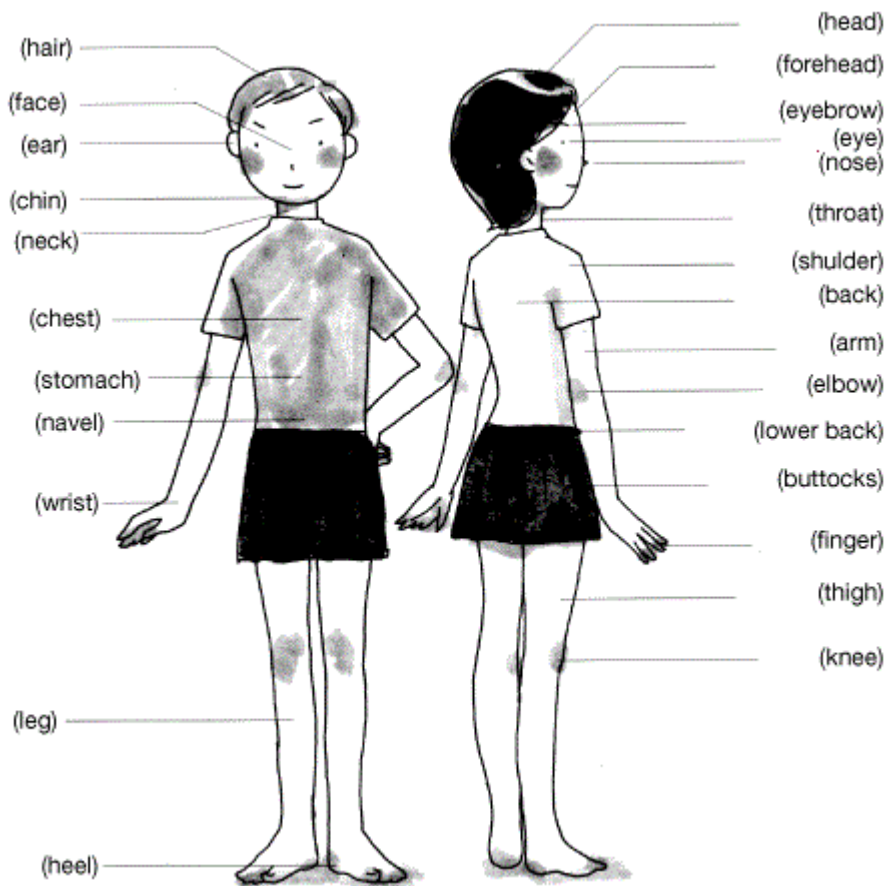

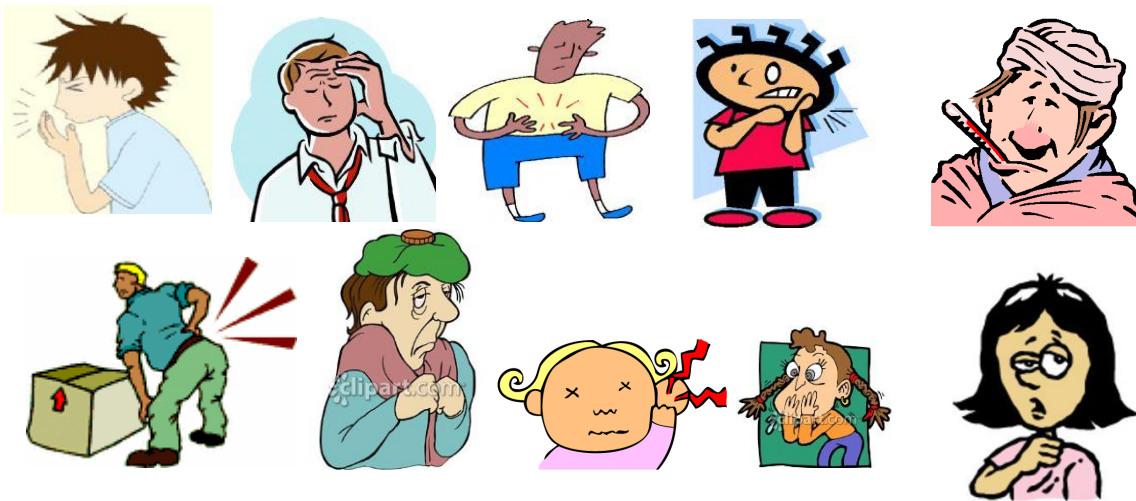
