<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>affirmative:</b> subject + past verb</li> <li><b>negative:</b> subject + <i>didn't</i> + verb</li> <li><b>question:</b> <i>did</i> + subject + verb</li> <li><b>Remember</b> that in the affirmative we use the <i>-ed</i> form in regular verbs and the form from the second column in irregular ones.
